HANDWASHING HELPS PREVENT MEASLES FROM SPREADING

In addition to vaccination, handwashing with soap can help prevent transmission of the measles virus.

WHAT YOU CAN DO:



Wash your hands regularly with soap. Scrub for at least 20 seconds.



Always wash your hands after coughing, sneezing, or covering your mouth or nose.



Model good handwashing behavior, and remind or help others to wash their hands with soap.



Ensure access to a place to wash hands with soap and water at home, school, work, and in other public places.
